Understanding the Importance of Analyzing Our Past for Future Insights

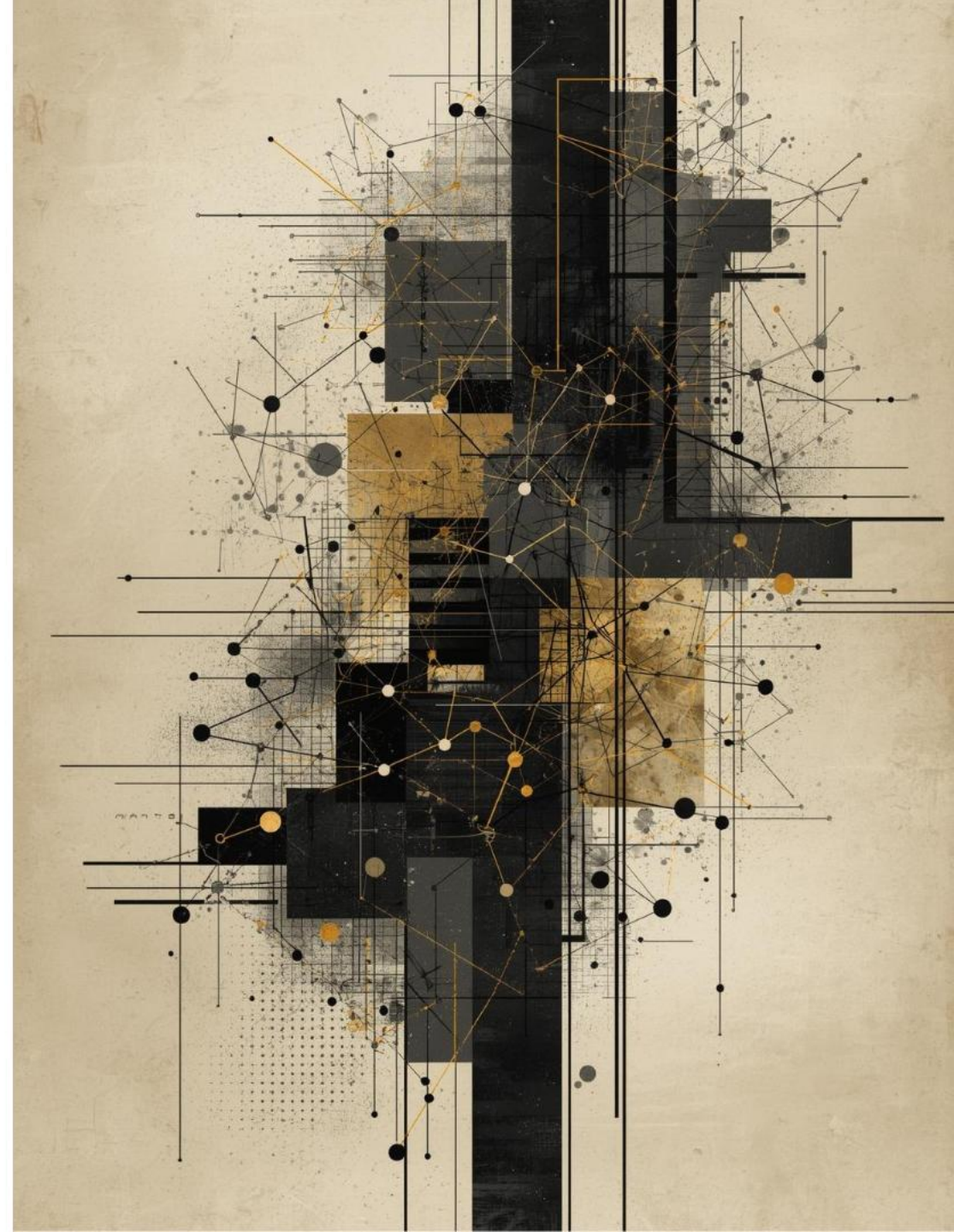

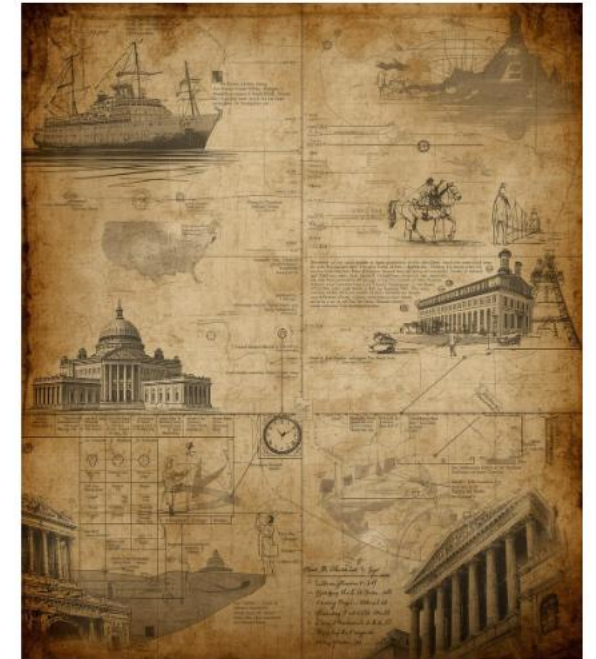
